

Leadership Summit FAQ

Q: Where is the leadership summit taking place?

- The leadership summit is taking place at [Camp Otterdale](#) in Ottawa. It is an approximate 3-hour drive from the Enactus Canada National Exposition venue and hotel.

Q: When is the leadership summit taking place? Will we be staying overnight?

- The leadership summit will take place from May 4-6, 2023, directly following the National Exposition.

Q: Do I need to pay to attend the leadership summit?

- 1 student leader from each team will be able to attend the summit at no cost. The second student will have to pay a fee of \$250 (this can be split between the 2 students as opposed to one student having to pay).

Q: How are we getting to and from the camp?

Enactus Canada will be providing transportation to and from the Leadership Summit from the Enactus Canada National Exposition hotel venue. Please see below for a summary of dates, locations and timing.

** It is mandatory that you arrive on time as the bus will be leaving exactly at 10:00am EST. If you are not there on time, you will not be attending the Leadership Summit. It's a 3-hour drive so dress comfortably!*

Q: What time will we be back in Montreal? What time should I book my flight home for?

- We expect to be back in Montreal by 12:30pm EST on Saturday, May 6th. We recommend booking flights departing Montreal at 4:30pm or later.

Q: Will food be provided at the camp?

- Lunch and dinner will be provided on May 4th, all 3 meals on May 5th and breakfast on May 6th.
- Snacks and refreshments will be provided throughout the day.
- Dietary restrictions will be accommodated; please flag any dietary restrictions during registration.

Q: How does the camp look? What is the environment like?

- The camp is very rustic. You will have a cabin-like experience, but this also means you need to dress accordingly (wear layers, etc.).

Q: What are the camp accommodations like?

- You will be sleeping in a cabin with up to 8 other students of the same sex. There will be 1-2 Enactus staff members assigned to each cabin.
- A new, unused sleeping bag will be provided for your cabin bunk.
- There are several outhouses on site for bathroom use.
- There are also shower houses with private shower stalls available for showering. A schedule will be provided each day so that everyone gets a chance to take a private shower.
- Hot water will be available in showers and in the main kitchen of the camp.

Q: Is the camp accessible?

- As we are on a campground, the main dining hall (where food will be served and Enactus programming will take place) is accessible but to get to the cabins, you will have to travel across uneven terrain as the cabins are scattered across the camp.
- Please let us know what your accessibility requirements are, and we can plan assign you to a cabin that is closest to the main area of the camp. We will work together to try and find a solution!

Q: What will we be doing during our stay?

- The purpose of this summit is to provide a bonding experience for the student leaders. We will be running all sorts of activities throughout the day to give you a chance to connect, bond, and most importantly, have fun!
- We will also set some time aside for Student Leader programming.
- The full itinerary will be provided closer to the event.
- *Please note that there will be no water activities taking place. Since the season just began, the water will be too cold.*

Q: Is there Wi-Fi or cell-phone reception?

- There is cell-phone reception at the camp.
- Wi-Fi is available in the dining hall of the camp.

Q: Is smoking or vaping permitted at the camp?

- Smoking and vaping are permitted in designated areas of the camp and must only be done outside. Indoor smoking/vaping is prohibited. Anyone caught smoking or vaping indoors will be escorted off the camp.

Q: Will alcohol or cannabis be permitted?

- Alcohol, cannabis, or any sort of recreational drugs are not permitted on campgrounds. This is a strict policy. If you do not adhere to this policy, we will be escorting you to the nearest bus station to arrange transportation home at your own cost.

Q: Is there anything you recommend we bring with us?

- We encourage all students to bring their own sleeping bag and pillow or single sheet set/pillow/pillowcase, however, if you are unable to bring your own, please indicate that in your registration and one will be provided to you.
- Bring comfortable clothes. We will be running some games and activities so make sure to bring running shoes (or at least closed-toe shoes) as well.
- If you have any allergies, make sure to bring your appropriate medications.
- Feel free to bring games or items you think will enhance your social experience.
