Post-Secondary Social Innovators Vie for National Titles at the Enactus Canada Expo in Calgary

Calgary, Alberta, May 1, 2025 – From May 6–8, Canada's brightest young entrepreneurs will converge at the Calgary TELUS Convention Centre for the **Enactus Canada National Exposition**. Fifty-two student teams from post-secondary schools nationwide will present social impact projects and business ventures addressing pressing issues such as climate change, youth empowerment, and economic inequality. Over 800 students, faculty, and business leaders from across the country will bring more than \$250,000 in economic impact and tourism to the city throughout the three-day event.

Teams will compete for national titles, over \$60,000 in funding, and a chance to represent Canada at the **Enactus World Cup** in Bangkok, Thailand in September.
